Dr Aravindan Veiraiah is the Director of the National Poisons Information Service Edinburgh, and a Consultant in Acute Medicine and Toxicology at the Royal Infirmary of Edinburgh.

Dr Veiraiah is a Scottish Quality and Safety Fellow with a key role in maintaining and editing Toxbase, the online clinical resource provided by the NPIS.

He has provided clinical toxicology care directly to patients in the Emergency Department, Intensive Care Unit and a dedicated poisons ward, and is part of the 24/7 NPIS telephone enquiry service. As well as collaborating with UK Health Security Agency (HSA) in the management of some evolving poisons scenarios.
